Investment Strategy



The investment manager attempts to replicate the target index by investing all, or substantially all, of its assets in the stocks that make up the index, holding each stock in approximately the same proportion as its weighting in the index. In some cases, it may not be possible or practicable to purchase all of the securities comprising the Index, or to hold them in the same weighting as they represent in the Index. In those circumstances, the Fund may employ a sampling or optimization technique to construct the portfolio.
